#### **SOP: GRANT FOR PROFESSIONAL COURSES**

#### Introduction

1. Bombay Sappers Association has undertaken various charitable endeavors to fulfill the objectives of the trust. One such venture is giving grant for higher education on merit cum means basis to children of JCOs/OR, who are members of The Bombay Sappers Association. The present scheme of GALHE (Grant against Loan for Higher Education), which was linked with education loan, is being terminated. A new scheme i.e **Grant for Professional Courses** is being implemented wef FY 2016-17. The new scheme has been de-linked from education loan and the amount of grants to be given have been enhanced. The SOP of this scheme is given in succeeding paragraphs.

#### **Scheme**: Grant for professional courses

2. The scheme envisages providing financial assistance to the wards of JCOs/OR serving/retired, who are members of The Bombay Sappers Association (including all widows of Bombay Sappers), to pursue professional studies. It has been observed that the fees required to be paid for higher education is very high and JCOs/OR find it difficult to manage this amount. To tide over this situation partially, it has been decided that the **BSA will give 'grant' amount based on duration of the course @ Rs. 10,000/- per year of course.** 

(a) For four year course - Rs. 40,000/(b) For Three year course - Rs. 30,000/(c) For Two year course - Rs. 20,000/-

- 3. An amount of Rs. 10,000/- will be paid initially and thereafter Rs. 10,000/- will be paid annually on receipt of progress report. All Scholarship holders should pass in all subject at the end of each academic year with an average of 50% marks/score or equivalent grade(s). If they fail to do so next installment of scholarship will be withheld.
- 4. If the student discontinues the course before completion (an unlikely event), for whatever reason, the grant given to the parent will have to be returned by him immediately (within two months from the date of discontinuation).

#### **Procedure**

- 5. The grant will be provided to meritorious and needy children of members of Bombay Sappers Association. The total grant amount will not exceed the budget allocation for "Grant for professional courses.
- 6. Preference for education grant will be given to wards who get admission in an institution affiliated to a Government Recognized University or should be a Government college.
- 7. Education grant will be given to the wards of Bombay Sappers for pursuing professional education such as Engineering, Medical, Management (MBA) and Hotel Management. However, discretionary powers rest with the Management Committee for allotting education grant for any other discipline/course.
- 8. It is necessary to make a merit list of all applicants since the applicants may be more than available vacancies. It is difficult to make a merit list in each stream due to the fact that qualifying examinations are conducted by many institutes and marks obtained in different institutes can not be compared. All students wanting to take advantage of education grant must appear in entrance exam conducted by reputed institutions in that field (refer table given below). It is not necessary for them to obtain admission in that institute. They may take admission in any other recognized institute, even if it is not covered by the entrance exam. The marks obtained in the entrance exam will form one of the parameters for selection. The discipline, number of vacancies and details of qualifying examination are given in the Table below:-

- 9. <u>2<sup>nd</sup> Year Engineering/Medical Students</u>: Children of BSA members/Widows of Bombay Sappers who are studying in 2<sup>nd</sup> year of Engineering & Medical Streams are also eligible to apply. This is to facilitate children who have taken admission directly in 2<sup>nd</sup> year engineering after completing a diploma in engineering and also those children who could not apply in time in first year Engineering/Medical due to delay in the admission process etc. However only a few vacancies will be allotted for this purpose depending on availability of funds in that financial year. A separate merit list will be made for 2<sup>nd</sup> year applicants, using the merit cum means matrix illustrated in Appx A, except that mark/grading obtained in first year or final year of diploma will be considered at para 4 (a) (i) and 4 (b) (i) of Appx 'A' in this case. The decision of BSA in allotting vacancies for this purpose will be final.
- 10. The JCOs/OR desirous of getting grant for his ward will submit an application as shown at Appx 'B'.
- 11. The sanction of grant will be on merit cum means basis, based on the recommendations of the Board of Officers (BOO) nominated by the BSA. The BOO will ascertain the merit as well as the need after detailed scrutiny and verification of the educational documents submitted by the applicant and his financial status depending on current employment and other sources of income, as declared by him. Guidelines for selection of candidates for the grant are given at Appx 'A'. A final merit list and recommended grant amount for each applicant will be drawn out by the BOO for obtaining the approval of the Vice Chairman. The Vice Chairman will, thereafter, accord his approval for disbursement of the grant.

#### Repayment

12. The BSA will give grant Rs. 10,000/- per year of course, as mentioned above. In case the child does not complete the course, for whatever reason, the JCOs/OR will have to return the grant amount. A format to that effect in the form of an affidavit is given at Appx 'C'. However, in exceptional cases, if the circumstances for not completing the course are beyond the control of the parent (e.g. death of or serious health problem to the child), the amount may be waived off by the permission of the Management Committee.

#### **Application Form and Affidavit**

- 13. The application form and affidavit will be completed by the BSA member applying for the financial assistance. (See Appx 'B' and 'C').
- 14. All application for 'Grant for professional courses' should be sent immediately on obtaining admission in professional courses. Last date of receipt of application in BSA office will be 15 Sept every year.

#### **Conclusion**

- 15. All efforts will be made to finalise the Board Proceeding of this scheme by 15 Oct and transfer the grants to individuals bank accounts directly by 30 Oct of each year.
- 16. This SOP of Grant for professional courses will be reviewed every year for any changes to be made if required.
- 17. This SOP supersedes all previous SOPs and amendments of GALHE (Grant against Loan for Higher Education) issued till date.

#### SUGGESTED GUIDELINES FOR GRANT FOR PROFESSIONAL COURSES

1. The discipline, number of vacancies and details of qualifying examination are given in the Table below:-

- 2. It is essential that the student has actually obtained admission in the discipline.
- 3. While deciding inter-se priority following points will be considered:-
  - (a) Score obtained in the qualifying examination by the ward.
  - (b) Average yearly income of last year as per declaration of the JCOs/OR.
  - (c) Only one child of the JCOs/OR will be considered for grant.
- 4. It is difficult to evaluate ranking in each stream due to the fact that qualifying examinations are conducted by many institutes and marks obtained in different institutes can not be compared. All students wanting to take advantage of education grant must appear in entrance exam conducted by reputed institutions in that field (as given in para 1 above). It is not necessary for them to obtain admission in that institute. They may take admission in any other recognized institute, even if it is not covered by the entrance exam. The marks obtained in the entrance exam will form one of the parameters for selection. A merit list will be made for each discipline as shown below:-

#### (a) Medical

- (i) Take score of entrance exam of NEET/AIPMT.
- (ii) This score will be loaded with other factors to get final score.

#### (b) **Engineering**

- (i) Consider percentage of marks obtained in JEE (Main).
- (ii) This score will be loaded with other factors to get final score.

#### (c) Management (MBA)

- (i) Consider percentage of marks obtained in CAT.
- (ii) This score will be loaded with other factors to get final score.

#### (d) Hotel Management

- (i) Consider percentage marks obtained in JEE/NCHMCT (National Council of Hotel Mgmt & Catering Technology).
- (ii) This score will be loaded with other factors to get final score.
- 5. A sample matrix is given for engineering stream at Annex 1. Similar matrix is made for each stream separately to arrive at merit list in that stream.
